

**Grace Baptist Mission — Keith & Sarah Charlton – OneHundredFold** Please pray for the **Envision team in Abingdon 9-20 July**. The team of four will be trained in recording, editing and producing audio-books in English to help pastors in other countries. Continue to pray for the team members as they go home and continue to produce audio-books in their spare time over the coming months and years.

**Persecuted Church —** The Communist government of **China**, which allows a certain number of Chinese Bibles to be printed and distributed to churches every year, has banned the online sale of Chinese Bibles. There is an urgent need for the Word of God in China, where the Church is growing rapidly but many new believers are vulnerable to false teaching. Some have commented that the government seems to recognise the power of the Bible or they would not want to restrict its circulation.
