

Persecuted Church — Christians in **Algeria** feel they are being used as pawns in political power games. There are periods of repression and periods of greater freedom. In recent months things have been difficult, with several churches closed down by the authorities, and when the Evangelical Protestant Association applied to renew their registration they received no answer. Christians are also frustrated that it is so hard to get visas for theological trainers to come into the country and teach the believers. Pray that the Algerian authorities will allow Christians the buildings, resources and trainers that they long for and for the repeal of laws that make life so difficult for them. *Barnabas Fund*
