

Association of Grace Baptist Churches South East — High Wycombe Grace Baptist Church

Pure Church

A new book from Grace Publications, written by pastors from across the UK seeks to uphold and promote Grace Baptist theology. Several men from AGBCSE churches have contributed. Copies have been handed out at our AGM.

Grace Baptist Mission — Sarah Clay – Huaraz, Peru Please pray I can make the most of my time in Huaraz while I'm here. I have meetings in Lima from 8-12 October which include leadership team, meeting with accepted and prospective Peruvian missionaries, their church leadership and/or families. Pray that I can immediately put into practice some of what I learn at the September conference in Ecuador

Persecuted Church — Abdu Adel Ayad (aged 40), a Christian from the Egyptian village of Menbal, posted a link on Facebook comparing Islam with other religions. He was arrested on 6 July for "disdaining Islam". Three days later a Muslim mob rioted in Menbal, stoning Christian homes and shouting "Allahu Akbar [God is great]." Ninety Muslims were arrested. Pray that the charges against Abdu will be dropped. If found guilty, he faces up to five years in prison.

Affinity — The Association of Grace Baptist Churches South East serve one another in a variety of ways. While prayer, pastoral care and resourcing for evangelism would be their main concerns, the churches also co-operate in practical matters. They are currently looking for a new Company Secretary to start in the summer of 2019. Pray that the Lord would send them just the right man or woman to serve in this key role.

Congratulations to Heather & Paul on their marriage yesterday! We praise God for bringing them to this point in their lives and pray that they will continue to know the Lord's rich blessings.
